Likelihood

- 1 Very Low = less than one in 100 years
- 2 Low = between one in 10 years and one in 100 years
- 3 Medium = between yearly and one in 10 years
- 4 High monthly to yearly
- 5 Very High Daily to monthly

Consequences

- 1 Low Hazard = Minor Injury
- 2 Medium Hazard = Major Injury
- 3 Medium / High Hazard = Multiple Injuries
- 4 High Hazard = Single fatality
- 5 Very High Hazard = Multiple Fatalities
