Carriage & Wagon Delivery Manager

Reporting to the General Manager, this is a full time role, based at Tenterden Town Station. Responsible for the C&W department and the safe and efficient planning, examination, maintenance and overhaul of rolling stock to meet company requirements using a team of paid and volunteer staff.

Responsibilities will include:

- Ensuring a positive and progressive safety culture and safe working environment for all staff, compliant with legislation as required by HSE and ROGS
- Work in accordance with the K&ESR Safety Management System
- Maintain a flexible long term maintenance, overhaul and restoration plan to meet the needs of the K&ESR.
- Manage people related issues including fostering a one team approach and encouraging volunteer support
- Work within department budgets
- Monitor and investigate accidents / incidents in line with company policy.
