A28 Tenterden Road, Rolvenden

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow for gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A28 Tenterden Road, Rolvenden.

A closure is planned from 12th February 2022, with estimated completion by 20th February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (XW015W118052911-01186-02 - SGN). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on One.Network

A28 Tenterden Road will be closed between number 80 and the junction with A28 High Street.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while gas mains replacement works are undertaken by SGN.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A28 Tenterden Road/Rolvenden Hill/Rolvenden Road/West Cross/High Street/East Cross/Ashford Road/Silver Hill/Ashford Road, A262 Biddenden Road/Tenterden Road/High Street/Sissinghurst Road/Biddenden Road/The Street/Sissinghurst Road, A229 Wilsley Pound/Wilsley Green/Angley Road/Hartley Road/ Hawkhurst Road/Gills Green/Cranbrook Road, A268 Rye Road/Megrims Hill/Queen Street/Rye Road, A28 Hastings Road/High Street and vice versa.
